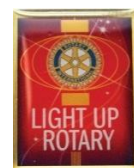

Dee gave us a brief history of her life growing up on Mt Hotham, Harrietville and in Bright.

Dee was born in 19.. and moved to Mt Hotham when she was one month old, Her parents owned the original Hotham Heights Hotel which burnt down in 1976. Dee said that she could ski before she could walk as it was easier to be towed than it was to walk in the snow. When it was time for her to start school, her family moved to Harrietville during the week but back to Hotham at weekends. Her High School days they moved to Wangaratta but returned to Harrietville for the Weekends.

When she left school she headed to Melbourne to work and was there for about four or five years, but in 1980 the mountains called her back to H/ville and she spent six months each year on Hotham working as the Administration Officer for the Ski School.

In 1991 she was employed by a local legal firm for about eleven years. A few different jobs and now she has been with the Bright Pine Valley Tourist Park in Bright for the last three years and is now happy to be part of the our Club.

Nominations for the Alpine Shire Youth Awards are now open. These awards are a fantastic way of recognising the great work that local young people do every day.

More often than not the contribution and achievement of our young people can go unrecognised, and these awards are our way of saying thanks.

These awards are organised and run by the Alpine Shire Youth Council, so it's as much about young people celebrating the achievements of their peers as it is about adults recognising young people.
