#### RE: FUNDRAISING FOR THE ALFRED TRAUMA CENTRE - THE ALFRED 6 HOUR.

The Alfred 6 Hour, Endurance Mountain Bike Race will be held on Saturday, September 19<sup>th</sup> in Bright. As you may be aware, the 2014 event raised over \$14,000.00 for The Alfred Hospital and this was, in part, due to the assistance of the Bright Rotary Club.


I am again requesting assistance with personnel on race day. The race course will have one check point staffed throughout the event. The checkpoint is in place as a safety measure. If a rider was injured or required assistance, the person on the check point would contact the race director by radio to arrange appropriate assistance. Check point personnel would not be required to hold a first aid certificate. (Ambulance Victoria will be onsite in the unlikely event of rider injury.)

The checkpoint is on Mystic Lane and easily accessible by 2WD vehicle (See attached Map). Ideally we would have two people at the checkpoint at any time. The checkpoint would need to be staffed from 9:45am to approx. 4:45pm. These points could be staffed on a rostering system eg. two hours at a time or by mutual agreement.
