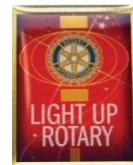

Keeping Rotary Relevant.

Rotary Down under for June has an article on the Rotary Club of Crawley. Crawley is on the Swan River outside of Perth CBD. The RC of Crawley is a young club that came to prominence a few years ago, when it was formed with members in their Twenties that dared to do things differently.

The Club is the Brainchild of a 79 years old Rotarian David Goldstone, a man with an irrepressible urge to challenge the status quo. He found that a number of young people had attended a Rotary Club meeting, but said that they would not go again. However, when the same young people were asked 'How about if I started a club just for young people? One where you set the agenda.' The response was very positive. So the RC of Crawley was born.

Whilst the RC of Crawley is comprised of young Rotarians, it is interesting that they have kept some of the trappings of Rotary. Whilst Rotary ways are followed by many Rotarians, change needs to be looked at so that we include the views of younger Rotarians. Every generation grows up in a different technological age and their ways of looking at things need to be considered. We get into habits very quickly

One of the ideas in the article was that the Subs for new members were subsidised for the first 2 years. We ask new members to pay up front, when they do not know what they have let themselves into. Rotary Can be daunting at the start as it is so big in terms of what programmes over the years.

Another idea was that Rotary District Conferences be open to the public. Key note speakers are often great and its share that only Rotarians are able to hear them.

Even the Rotary Down Under magazine has changed over the years and I do not hear complaints from Rotarians about having to purchase the Magazine as much as I used to hear.
