10.30am Head out on reasonably easy one and a half hour walk to Fitzgerald's Hut. (About a mile and a half of easy uphill on an SEC jeep track, followed by an hour or so of easy level going following a pole line in

the snow grass.

12.00pm Light the fire and have lunch at Fitzgerald's.

1.00pm Head back along the same route, with optional half hour detour to

nearby Kelly's Hut.

3.00pm Arrive back at vehicles. Head home (via the recently restored

Wallace's Hut for those who wish)

5.30pm Arrive back at Bright.
